The only examinations taking place outside of the examination week are:

- **Year 10 Music – this will take place during normal Music class during the week leading up to the internal examination period. If a pupil has missed this examination, then they are to be sent to MC2 at the start of the ‘Music Catch-up’ session for their year group during the examination week.**
- ❖ Pupils should go directly to their examination room each morning at 8.50 am.
- ❖ **Break will be from 10.30 – 10.50 am.**
- ❖ **Lunch will be from 12.30 – 1.15 pm.**
- ❖ On some days, there will be time for revision in the middle session and also before the start of some exams. Therefore, pupils are expected to plan in advance what they are going to revise and **bring suitable revision material** to enable them to study effectively during these times.
- ❖ During the examinations, no electronic equipment is allowed in the exam room. **All mobile phones, Apple Watches and mp3 players must be left at home or switched off and zipped in schoolbags.** Pupils will NOT be allowed to listen to music during revision time as this is not allowed in external exams. **Any pupil who is found to be using a mobile phone or an electronic device in an examination room will score zero in that exam and be put in detention.**
- ❖ During break and lunch pupils should stay away from the Performance Hall, the Gym, the Assembly Hall and the Sports Hall as senior pupils will be doing exams in these areas at this time.
- ❖ Pupils are not allowed in the exam rooms during lunch. Pupils should be careful not to leave important items on their desk such as calculators, etc.
- ❖ If you are absent and miss any exams then you must inform your subject teachers on the first day you return to school.
